

Virtual Visits software installation instructions.

Before linking to the website, Flash must be installed on all pcs being used. Using Internet Explorer, enter the site at the following URL:

www.sebvirtuallearning.org.uk

The software requires Vislite and Flash to operate. Flash needs to be installed, but Vislite is downloaded automatically when you log in. It will only need to install once. Some problems have been experienced due to the Active - X setup.

To try out the package you will need to register. For setting up it would be useful for the login to be one of the teachers responsible for the trial.

Try out the package using the first option of a free visit to the airport. If a red cross appears Vislite has not loaded.

If you have an image, you can move around the virtual world using the navigator (Navbar) in the lower middle of the screen. If the graphics are not clear or appear jumbled, double click the chip to the right of the navigator. A cross will appear on the chip, and the graphics should now be fully visible. You are now bypassing the graphics card on the pc.

You can now navigate around all the worlds using the cursor keys as well as the standard mouse movement. If you hold down the SHIFT key while pressing a cursor key, the movement speed is doubled. This may help users who have trouble using the NavBar.

The whole environment is built up of 5 worlds. You may be moving between worlds and encounter a 'wall'. If a hand has appeared as the cursor, double-click and you will move into the adjacent world. This has been necessary due to file sizes.

A further trial is to now use the Mother and baby option. A map can be located using the arrow on the top right of the window. The baby change facility is on the first floor above the information desk (a white door in the wall next to the food area). Maps are due for upgrading.
